"Dialogues", the III International Graduate Student Conference invites young philosophers and scholars to share their ideas. This interdisciplinary conference theme is **Philosophy and Contemporary World**, and we welcome contributions from all areas in the humanities, including literature, education, history and art, as well as from the sciences.

This conference will focus on two issues: the role of philosophy in the present world and the relationship between philosophical thinking and life.

The last two centuries have been characterized by rapid changes in our social, intelectual and artistic worlds. Philosophers have failed to explain these changes and thought in general seems to be defeated. We argue, however, that reflecting on the role of philosophy is more important today than ever. We want to examine issues that include, but are not limited to: philosophy's public value, the philosophies behind our age's cultural manifestations, the limits of philosophical thought, whether it continues to be an academic discipline, the interconnection between philosophy and other sciences, and the possibility of life without philosophy.

The "Dialogues" Conference will take place from January 31th and February 1st 2014. Participants must be graduate students or upper-level undergraduates. Abstracts of 500 words should be sent to: <u>organizacion@congresodialogos.com</u> before December 15th, 2013. Participants will be notified of the status of their proposal before December 22th. Travel stipends are available for those travelling from outside Navarra. The Instituto de Antropología y Ética of the University of Navarre offers finantial support for those who discuss about the role of philosophy in the University or the relationship between philosophy and religion.

You may participate with either:

1.- With a **individual paper (between** 2,000 and 3,000 words).

2.- With a 10-minute self-made video.

3.- With **a poster or art work.**. Those choosing this third way must let the organization know, so that their work enjoy proper exhibition.

The conference is open to those interested in the topic, regardless of whether they present a paper or not. They must, however, register through the conference website before January 25, 2014.
