Carlos Gamazo graduated with a BSc. (Biology) from University of Navarra, and subsequently carried out PhD research in the area of Microbiology. After completing his PhD on vaccination, he went on to work as a Post-doctoral Research Fellow in the Department of Immunology at Cornell University (New York) in the period 1986-88. Further, in 1991, he was a visiting professor in the Department of Immunology at the University of Madison-Wisconsin. Since 1988 he was appointed as Lecturer in Microbiology in the School of Pharmacy, University of Navarra, acting as Full Professor since 2004. His main area of research interest is in the development of vaccines, with a particular focus on antigen delivery systems as immunoadjuvants. He is the author of over one hundred publications in reviewed scientific Journals and currently holds eight patents.
