



## UNIVERSITY OF NAVARRA FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM

Regulatory Academic Year 2026-2027

### 1. PRESENTATION

The University of Navarra announces the **University of Navarra Financial Aid Program** to ensure that students with good academic records that are unable to enroll due to their financial situation, can access to study their programs of study of Degree at the University of Navarra.

Through this call for applications, the University will grant personalized assistance which, in addition to the family contribution, will allow the student to study at this University. The scholarship will be allocated exclusively to cover tuition expenses; it will not be granted for accommodation costs.

### 2. REQUIREMENTS

#### *a) Access to the Grant Program*

- Complete an application for admission to the first year of undergraduate studies at the University of Navarra for the 2026-2027 academic year, also requesting a Cost and Scholarship Study.
- Have obtained a minimum average grade of 7 points out of 10 in the first year of Baccalaureate or equivalent studies.
- Have a per capita household income in 2024 of no more than €25,000 and a return on capital assets for that year of less than €3,000 (see ANNEX I for details).

#### *b) Renewal of aid in higher-level courses*

To renew the aid, the following requirements must be met:

- Pass all subjects enrolled in during the 2026-2027 academic year, between the first and second sittings.
- Achieved an average grade of 7.00 in the 2026-2027 academic year.
- Ensure that the family's financial situation remains similar to that certified at the time of admission to the program, and the financial requirements set out in the applicable regulations are fulfilled.

### 3. CHARACTERISTICS OF THE AID

- This aid is compatible with other bonus or discounts offered by the University of Navarra, such as those for large families, honors, or the Undergraduate Studies Incentive Plan.
- University of Navarra Aid **is not compatible** with the Alumni Scholarship Program or other scholarship programs offered by the University, nor with the Early Payment Discount.
- However, it is compatible with public scholarships and other private calls, and students commit



to applying for them when they meet the eligibility requirements.

- The sum of all scholarships and aid awarded for tuition may never exceed the registration fee. If it does, the difference will be subtracted from the University of Navarra Aid.
- When resolving the application for this aid, after a thorough analysis of the family situation, the amount granted will be determined.

#### 4. APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION

##### *a) Access to the Program*

- Students must complete their application for admission to the 2026-2027 academic year for the degree they wish to study and provide the documentation required to complete the Cost and Scholarship Study.
- If the requirements set forth in this call are met, the prospective student will be shown the option to apply for this scholarship in the results of their assessment, under the SCHOLARSHIPS AND AID tab in the miUNAV portal.
- To formalize the application, the candidate must submit the following documentation via the APPLICATION button:
  - A motivation letter from the student highlighting their achievements and merits.
  - A document explaining the family's financial situation, quantifying the income they can contribute and the amount of aid requested.
- If more information is needed, the Student Financing Office may contact the family to conduct an interview.

##### *b) Renewal of the Aid*

Students who benefit from the University of Navarra's Aid Program during the 2025-2026 academic year must apply to renew their aid for the 2026-2027 academic year, following the instructions established in the regulations published for that academic year.

#### 5. APPLICATION DEADLINE AND DECISION

##### *a) Access to the Program*

- First application deadline: **December 13, 2025**, with a decision starting January 21, 2026.
- Second application deadline: **March 14, 2026**, with a decision by April 16, 2026.
- Extraordinary deadline: **May 16, 2026**, with a decision by May 26, 2026.

In certain cases, if the student has already been admitted to the University, a decision on their aid application before the indicated date will be considered.



*b) Renewal of the Aid*

Single application period: from **June 1 to June 15, 2026**, with a decision issued before July 15.

**6. ACCEPTANCE**

Acceptance of the University of Navarra Aid Program will be confirmed by the student's payment of the tuition fees, following the instructions given in the decision on their aid application.

**7. RECOVERY OF THE AID**

If a student benefiting from this University of Navarra Aid Program does not meet the academic or financial requirements to renew it in subsequent academic years, they may reapply for it in subsequent academic years as long as they meet the renewal requirements established in the call for applications.

## ANNEX I

The annual per capita income of the family unit is defined as the result of dividing the sum of all income earned by all eligible family members by the family size. Income earned by children will be counted at 50%.

Eligible members are: the student applicant, the father, mother, legal guardian, if applicable, and unmarried siblings under the age of 25 who live in the family home as of December 31 of the year under study.

The procedure for calculating family income is based on the Personal Income Tax:

"General taxable base" + "Savings taxable base" - "Taxable amount resulting from self-assessment" + "Exempt income".
