



## GIPUZKOAN TALENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - TECNUN

### Regulations for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The School of Engineering at the University of Navarra (Tecnun) announces the **VII Edition of the Gipuzkoan Talent Scholarship Program** for undergraduate studies during the 2026-2027 academic year.

This financial aid is intended for students whose fiscal residence is in Gipuzkoa and who wish to study at Tecnun. It will be applied by reducing the tuition fee. The amount will be calculated individually based on the student's situation and **may cover up to 40% of the tuition cost**.

#### 2. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

##### a) Access to the Program

- The student and their family must reside in the province of Gipuzkoa.
- The average high school grade must be higher than 8,5 (if the high school was completed outside Spain, equivalency will be considered).
- Maximum per capita income in the last 2 years (2023 and 2024): 20,000 euros.

##### b) Scholarship Renewal

- Students who received the aid during the 2025-2026 academic year may apply for renewal if they pass all enrolled ECTS credits, including both first and second exams.
- Maximum per capita income for the year 2025: 20,000 euros.

#### 3. DOCUMENTATION AND APPLICATION DEADLINE

##### a) Access to the Program

- To access the program, it is necessary to apply for admission to the School of Engineering through the [miUNAV](#) portal and complete the Cost and Scholarships Study during the process.
- If the requirements established in this call are met, the future student will be shown the option to apply for this scholarship in the result of their assessment, under the SCHOLARSHIPS AND AID tab in the miUNAV portal.
- To formalize the application, the candidate must submit, via the APPLICATION button, the following documentation:
  - A brief report explaining the reasons why the scholarship is needed.
  - Income tax return for the year 2023 for all family members who have filed it. If a member has not filed a return, provide a certificate from the tax office indicating the income received that year.
- There is a **single application deadline** which ends on **March 14, 2026**, with a decision on **April 16, 2026**.



## b) Scholarship Renewal

- It is necessary to apply for the renewal of the scholarship at the end of each academic year.
- Through the **Help/Contact menu** in the [miUNAV portal](#), students who have benefited from this aid in the 2025–2026 academic year and have passed all courses must provide the following documentation:
  - Income tax return for the year 2025 for all family members who have filed it. If a member has not filed a return, provide a certificate from the tax office indicating the income received that year.
- The renewal application period is from **June 1 to June 15, 2026**, with the decision communicated from **June 30, 2026**.

## 4. SCHOLARSHIP CHARACTERISTIC

- The Gipuzkoan Talent Scholarship at Tecnun is compatible with University discounts provided that the total does not exceed 70% of the tuition cost (for example, large family discount, honors enrollment discount, University affiliation discount, etc.), unless explicitly stated otherwise. The resolution will indicate the total aid granted to the student in each case.
- It is not compatible with other scholarship programs offered by the University of Navarra, nor with the Early Payment Discount.
- The scholarship must be requested when starting studies at Tecnun, from the first year, and cannot be requested once the student is enrolled in higher years.
- The amount granted will be applied at the time of enrollment, once compliance with the requirements for average grade, residence, and renewal (if applicable) has been verified.

## 5. ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance of the Gipuzkoan Talent Scholarship will be confirmed by the payment of the enrollment fees by the student within the deadline set by the Admissions Service, according to the instructions and deadline communicated in the scholarship application decision.

## 6. SCHOLARSHIP RECOVERY

If a scholarship recipient fails to meet the academic or economic requirements to renew it in subsequent years, they may reapply in future years provided they meet the renewal requirements established in the call.
