



DON ERNESTO FERNÁNDEZ HOLMANN SCHOLARSHIPS - UNIVERSITY OF NAVARRA

Regulations for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

1. INTRODUCTION

The Don Ernesto Fernández Holmann - University of Navarra scholarship program aims to enable Nicaraguan students with limited financial resources to pursue their undergraduate or master's studies at the University of Navarra.

When analyzing the granting of the scholarship and its amount, the special circumstances of the country will be considered to facilitate the future student's studies at the University of Navarra.

This scholarship is incompatible with other scholarship programs at the University of Navarra for both undergraduate and master's programs, but it can be combined with tuition discounts or personalized tuition amounts.

2. SCHOLARSHIP CHARACTERISTICS

Scholarships will be awarded for a personalized amount, which will be determined by the selection committee for that call, following an analysis of the future student's financial situation conducted by the University of Navarra's Financial Aid Office. This scholarship may be applied to both tuition and accommodation expenses; however, the full cost of tuition must be covered first.

3. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

A) Access to the Program

- Applicants must have Nicaraguan nationality.
- The family's per capita income in 2024 must be less than 20,000 euros.
- The applicant must have been admitted to study at the University of Navarra for the 2026-2027 academic year.
- It is a mandatory requirement that the applicant applies to all public and private scholarship programs that match their profile.

B) Renewal of the scholarship for 2026-2027

- The applicant must have performed well in all courses enrolled in during the 2025-2026 academic year.
- The annual per capita income of the family unit in 2025 must be less than 20,000 euros.
- The renewal application must be submitted within the established deadline.



4. APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION

a) Access

The future student must apply for admission to one of the degree programs offered by the University through the [miUNAV](#) portal, also requesting a Cost and Scholarship Study.

- If the requirements established in this call are met, the future student will be shown the option to apply for this scholarship in the result of their assessment, under the SCHOLARSHIPS/FINANCIAL AID tab in the miUNAV portal.
- To formalize the application, the candidate must submit, via the APPLICATION button, an explanatory statement of their study plan and professional development project.
- In this statement, the applicant must clearly express their interest and personal motivation for pursuing the studies for which they are requesting the Fernández-Holmann Scholarship, as well as the reasons that led them to choose the University of Navarra. This text will be a key element in the selection of beneficiaries; therefore, it is expected to be as specific as possible.

b) Renewal

It is necessary to apply for the scholarship renewal through the [miUNAV](#) portal in the **HELP/CONTACT** section, indicating the composition and economic situation of the family and attaching proof of income for 2024 from all eligible family members who have filed tax returns.

5. APPLICATION DEADLINE AND RESOLUTION

a) Program Access

Until **March 14, 2026**, with resolution before **April 16, 2026**.

b) Scholarship Renewal

Single period: from **June 1 to June 15, 2026**. The resolution will be communicated before **July 15, 2026**.

In certain cases, if the student already has certifiable grades, their application for aid may be considered for resolution before the indicated date.

6. FAMILY INCOME CALCULATION

The annual per capita income of the family unit is calculated by dividing the total income of all eligible family members by the number of members. Income earned by the children is weighted at 50%.

The following are considered eligible family members: the applicant, the father, the mother, the legal guardian (if applicable), and single siblings under 25 years old who lived at the family home as of December 31 of the last fiscal year.

7. OBSERVATIONS

- The Financial Aid Study reserves the right to request any additional documentation necessary to understand the real economic situation of the family unit.
- The scholarship will not be granted if there is inconsistency in the documentation provided or if the economic situation lacks credibility.
- The final number of scholarships awarded will be subject to the budget allocated for this purpose.
- The sum of all scholarships and aid granted to a student for tuition can never exceed the cost of the registration fees for the academic year for which they are applying.
