



SCIENCE AND TALENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OF NAVARRA

Regulations for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

1. PRESENTATION:

The Faculty of Sciences of the University of Navarra announces **the VIII Edition of the Science and Talent Scholarship Program of Navarra** for the 2026-2027 academic year. The program is aimed at students who wish to pursue their undergraduate studies at the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Navarra but are unable to enroll due to their financial situation despite having an excellent academic record.

2. SCHOLARSHIP CHARACTERISTIC

The Science and Talent Scholarship is intended to cover the necessary tuition expenses for studying at the University of Navarra, always complementing the family's financial contribution. This family contribution may vary depending on individual circumstances, but the goal is for it to be similar to the cost of academic fees at public universities.

Based on an individualized assessment of each application, which considers the public scholarships and grants the candidate may access, the amount of the Scholarship to be applied to the tuition cost for the 2026-2027 academic year will be determined. The scholarship recipient is required to apply for all public scholarships for which they are eligible and to pay the University any tuition-related aid received.

The Science and Talent Scholarship of Navarra will be renewed annually as long as the requirements established in the call are met. The amount for renewals will be determined on a personalized basis according to the family's financial circumstances.

3. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

a) Access to the program

To be eligible for this Scholarship Program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Have their family residence in the Autonomous Community of Navarra.
- Have completed the admission application for the 2026-2027 academic year in any of the undergraduate degrees offered by the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Navarra, requesting the Cost and Scholarship Study.
- Obtain a minimum average grade of 8 out of 10 in high school or equivalent studies.
- Pass the EVAU (University Entrance Examination) in the ordinary call.
- Financial requirements: have a per capita income not exceeding €20,000 in 2024 and the maximum net yield of movable capital plus the net positive balance of capital gains should be less than €3,000.

For income calculation, all income received for any reason by all members of the family unit during 2024 will be considered. The family unit includes the applicant's father, mother, or legal guardian and children under 25 years of age who lived in the family home as of December 31, 2024. Children's income will be counted at 50%.

b) Scholarship Renewal

Students from the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Navarra who participated in the Science and Talent Scholarship Program during the 2025-2026 academic year can continue to benefit from the aid in the 2026-2027 academic year, provided they meet the following criteria:

- Pass all the subjects they enrolled in during the 2025-2026 academic year.
- Continue to meet the economic requirements established to access the Program.
- Request the renewal of the scholarship within the deadlines established in the call.
- Achieve in the 2025-2026 academic year the average grade indicated depending on the year of admission and the degree pursued:
 - Admission in the 2021-2022 academic year and earlier: for all degrees, an average **grade of 7 out of 10.**
 - Admission in the 2022-2023 academic year and later:
 - Degrees in Biology, Biochemistry, Environmental Sciences, and double degree in Biology + Environmental Sciences: average **grade of 7.50 out of 10.**
 - Degree in Chemistry and double degree in Chemistry + Biochemistry: average **grade of 7 out of 10.**

4. SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION

a) Access to the program

- To access the Program, it is necessary to apply for admission to the Faculty of Sciences through the [miUNAV portal](#) and complete the Cost and Scholarship Study during the process.
- If the requirements established in this call are met, the future student will be shown the option to apply for this scholarship under the SCHOLARSHIPS AND AID tab in the miUNAV portal.
- To formalize the application, the candidate must submit, via the APPLICATION button, a brief statement explaining the reasons for choosing the University of Navarra and the selected degree, their motivation for applying for the Science and Talent Scholarship of Navarra, and their envisioned professional goals upon completing their university studies.

b) Scholarship Renewal

- It is necessary to apply for the renewal of the scholarship at the end of each course as long as the requirements established in this call are met.
- Through the **Help/Contact** menu on the [miUNAV portal](#), students who have benefited from this aid in the 2025-2026 academic year must provide the following documentation:
 - Income tax return for the year 2025 from all family members who have filed it. If any member does not file a tax return, a certificate of income attribution from the Foral Treasury indicating the income received in that year must be provided.

5. APPLICATION DEADLINE AND RENEWAL

a) Access to the program

- First period: until **December 13, 2025**, with resolution starting January 21, 2026.



- Second period: until **March 14, 2026**, with resolution starting April 16, 2026.
- Extraordinary period: from **June 1 to June 15, 2026**, with resolution before June 30, 2026.

b) Scholarship Renewal:

- Application deadline: from **June 1 to 15, 2026**.
- Resolution: from **June 30, 2026**.

6. GRANTING

The granting of the scholarship is not guaranteed by the fulfillment of the required criteria. It is subject to the availability of funds in the Science and Talent Scholarship Program of NAVARRA at the UNIVERSITY OF NAVARRA and the evaluation by the Scholarship Committee. This committee will consist of the head of the Study Financing Office of the Admissions Service, the Director of Development of the Faculty of Sciences, and the Director of the Administrative Economic Service.

When the scholarship award is communicated, the student will be informed of the total amount granted to study at the University of Navarra. This scholarship is compatible with other discounts offered by the University, which will be taken into account when determining the award, except for the Early Payment Discount, which is not compatible.

7. ACCEPTANCE

Acceptance of the Science and Talent Scholarship of Navarra will be confirmed by the student paying the enrollment fees within the deadline set by the Admissions Service, according to the instructions and deadline communicated in the scholarship resolution.

8. SCHOLARSHIP RECOVERY

If a student who is a beneficiary of this scholarship does not meet the academic or economic requirements to renew it in subsequent courses, they may reapply for it in successive courses as long as they meet the renewal requirements established in the call.
