She explains how it is possible using the main idea: "La mujer como transformadora de la cultura." (Women as transformers of the culture).

One of the main problems for women of today's society is that they are forced to choose one cultural dimension: between that culture that enrich us with all kind of diverse knowledge and that one seemed as tradition.

She argues that the combination of both is the key to happiness in the long-run even though it encourages a selfless lifestyle taking care of others.
