The purpose of VEiB Network is to provide a global forum to promote virtue ethics and the common good in business and management through research, teaching and consultancy activities.


This newsletter is to inform you about what’s going on and thus help you plan your own virtue ethics in business-related activities: you will find VEiB activities and upcoming events in the next pages.

Please find attached a very rough draft (not for citation or circulation outside of VEiB Network) of a chapter on practical wisdom that may help you get started on your own work.


