



## PROGRAMA DE DOCTORADO EN CREATIVIDAD APLICADA

### PREREQUISITES

Universidad de Navarra has approved the “Instruction on Doctorate Programs of Universidad de Navarra” of October 2011, where, pursuant to RD 99/2011 of 28 January, regulating official doctoral programs, the general access to doctorate studies is regulated.

1. In general terms, in order to access an official doctoral program, it shall be necessary to hold an official Spanish Undergraduate, or equivalent, or a Master's degree, or equivalent, providing that at least 300 ECTS credits have been successfully completed in both programs altogether;

2. Likewise, candidates can be admitted if one of the following applies:

a) They hold an official, Spanish university degree, or one from the European Higher Education Area, granting access to a Master's Degree pursuant to the provisions established in Article 16 of Royal Decree 1393/2007 of 29 October, and they have completed a minimum of 300 ECTS credits including all official university studies, of which at least 60 must have been at a Master's Degree level.

b) They hold an official Spanish degree which, in line with European Law, is made up of at least 300 ECTS credits. Such graduates must obligatorily undertake the training complements outlined in section 7.2 herein, unless the syllabus of the relevant Undergraduate Degree includes research credits equivalent to research credits in a Master's Degree in terms of training value.

c) Graduates who have successfully completed at least two years of training in a program leading to the obtainment of an official degree of any of the specialties in Health Science after obtaining a training position through the relevant access examination for specialised sanitary training.

d) They hold a degree from a foreign education authority that does not need to be validated due to it having previously been checked by the University that it certifies the level equivalent to an official Spanish Master's degree and that in the issuing country it grants access to doctorate studies. Admission by this route shall not imply, in any case, that the previous degree has been recognised for any other purpose than undertaking this Doctorate program.

e) They have a Spanish Doctorate qualification which was achieved under the previous university system.

f) They have an official university degree that is equivalent to level 3 of the Spanish Framework of Qualifications for Higher Education, as set out in the established procedure in Royal Decree 967/2014 of 21 November which establishes the requirements and procedure for the validation and attestation of the equivalence of a degree certificate and of the accreditation of studies completed outside the European Higher Education Area, and the process to determine the equivalence to the levels of the Spanish Framework of Qualifications for Higher Education of the official qualifications of Architecture, Engineering, Technical Architecture, Technical Engineer and Diplomas.

Admission to the Doctoral Degree in Applied Creativity shall be ruled by the specific criteria of the program provided the general admission requirements for Universidad de Navarra are met.
