





Erasmus+ Programme Bilateral Inter-Institutional Agreement

Key Action 1

Learning Mobility for Higher Education Students and Staff among EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme ¹

The institutions agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, including automatic recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution as agreed in the Learning Agreement and confirmed in the Transcript of Records, or according to the learning outcomes of the modules completed abroad, as described in the Course Catalogue, in line with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System. The institutions agree on exchanging their mobility related data in line with the technical standards of the European Student Card Initiative.

The Polish grading system: Grades are given from 5 to 2.

National Grading System

Each course is graded on a scale from 1 to 5, as a minimum and maximum pass grade, respectively. Some exams can be evaluated by pass or by sufficient, good or excellent.

Credits (1 credit = 25 hours total work)

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

A percentage grading distribution will be provided to each Transcript of Records, according to the single class degree and the average of the last three years

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **5 weeks*** after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

*This deadline may change accordingly to the end of the evaluation period.

Termination of the agreement

This agreement will remain in effect for the above determined period of validity or until the involved institutions both agree in the discontinuation of the exchanges. It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the interinstitutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least

one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
