<b>Project Description</b>	ATLANTES is a Medical Humanities Research Program, which aims to promote a positive attitude towards palliative care. The research lines are a) Intangibles values in Palliative Care b) Global Palliative Care and c) The Palliative Care to the professionals and the society. ATLANTES works from a vision based on the dignity of the person and of professional care, including respect to the natural course of the illness and attention to the spiritual and emotional dimensions of the person. The ATLANTES research team is interdisciplinary and international, with researchers and assistants' researchers with different backgrounds (sociology, nursing, physiotherapy, medicine and history) and from different countries. The research program is now in its sixth year.
