

The University of Navarra began operating in Pamplona in 1952 as a result of the initiative of St. Josemaría Escrivá de Balaguer. It currently offers 57 undergraduate degrees, 46 master's degrees and 23 doctoral programs distributed over four campuses (Pamplona, San Sebastián, Madrid and Barcelona).

The University of Navarra has been ranked third in the Europe Teaching Rankings 2019 (source: Times Higher Education), behind the universities of Oxford and Cambridge.

The ecclesiastical faculties (Theology, Canon Law and Philosophy) are located in the main campus of the university, adjacent to the historic city of Pamplona, the capital of the Old Kingdom of Navarra (Spain). Its population of more than 200,000, its geographical location and its historical and cultural heritage make it a privileged place to live and study.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Our intensive **Summer Program** helps students to greatly improve their oral and written communication skills in Spanish. Students will study at the University of Navarra main campus located in the beautiful northern city of Pamplona.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

After the first week on the Camino de Santiago, all students will take a **Written and Oral Spanish Communication Course**. The schedule includes four class hours per day Monday to Friday for **3 weeks (60 class hours)**. Students will be placed in courses appropriate to their knowledge of Spanish.

HOUSING

The program provides lodging and meals in the **International Seminary Bidasoa**, 40-minute walk or short bus ride from the University. Students will be staying with seminarians from Latin American countries. This will provide them an excellent opportunity for Spanish conversation and other activities.

PROGRAM FEES

- » **Tuition and Certificate:** 350 €
- » **Housing with full board (3 meals daily):** 750 €
- » **Co-Curricular activities:** 800 €

Please note that the program fee does not include the cost of travel to and from Pamplona. Participants are expected to make their own travel arrangements.

- » **Deadline for registration:** 31st March



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



The last six stages of the 'Camino de Santiago'

The first week (July 4th – 11th) will consist of walking it from Cebreiro to Santiago de Compostela (103 miles). On the way to Cebreiro, we will stop in Burgos to visit the cathedral.

Weekly co-curricular activities are included to enrich the students' understanding of Spanish religious traditions and their influence in Latin America. Students will have the opportunity to visit historical sites and learn about the region's unique Catholic culture. The following trips and activities in and around Pamplona include:



Castillo de Javier

the birthplace of St Francis Xavier (40m by car; 34 miles).



Loyola

the birthplace of St Ignatius (1h 30m; 62 miles).



Shrine of Lourdes

France (2h 50m; 155 miles).



Zaragoza, Our Lady of the Pilar

Patroness of all Hispanic peoples (1h 50m; 108 miles).
