Dr. Gil-Bazo is MD and PhD in Medicine and Surgery from the University of Navarra School of Medicine. He is Medical Oncologist since 2004 with special interest in the study and treatment of lung cancer and genitourinary tumors.

He completed his training as a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York (USA), in the Cancer Biology and Genetics Program. He received his Medical Oncology Certificate in 2012 from the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO).

He leads the laboratory for New Therapeutic Targets at the Center for Applied Medical Research (CIMA), with special interest in drug resistance and metastasis mechanisms in lung cancer.

Dr. Gil-Bazo has also served in more than 35 clinical trials as principal investigator mainly for lung and prostate cancer, and in more than 40 trials as co-investigator.

He has served as member of the editorial board for World Journal of Gastroenterology and is currently reviewer for Cancer Research, Clinical Cancer Research, Oncotarget, Tumor Biology, Critical Reviews in Oncology and Haematology and Clinical Genitourinary Cancer.

He has published more than 70 articles in international journals including New England Journal of Medicine, Lancet Oncology, Cancer Research, Clinical Cancer Research, Oncogene, British Journal of Cancer etc.

He has presented more than 40 scientific communications at international oncology meetings and is co-author of a Cellular Biology book (Elsevier) and various book chapters in oncology and molecular biology.
