# ADMISSION CRITERIA

**Master in  
Banking and Financial  
Regulation**

The admission criteria are:

- Holding a Bachelor or equivalent.
- Accreditation of academic record
- Curriculum vitae
- English level accreditation.
- Recommendation letters.

The selection of the candidates is based on the evaluation of their academic record, their Curriculum Vitae, letters of recommendation (both the content and the prestige of signatory), the prestige of the candidate's University of origin and their level of English.

The level of knowledge of the English language required to access the program may be justified according to any of the following criteria:

- TOELF (iBT) (Test of English as Foreign Language): >87 (equivalent to a B2).
- Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE). Equivalent to a C1.
- Cambridge English: Proficiency (CAF). Equivalent to a C2.
