SUMMER 2019 IN SPAIN Intensive Spanish Language Program July 8th to 26th, University of Navarra, Barcelona

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Our intensive Summer Program helps students greatly improve their oral and written communicative abilities in Spanish in just three weeks. Students will study at IESE Business School campus, located in the beautiful Mediterranean city of Barcelona.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

All students will take a Spanish Written and Oral Communication Course, for a total of 6 ECTS, four class hours per day Monday to Friday for 3 weeks (60 class hours). Students will be placed in beginning, intermediate, or advanced level courses. Syllabi are available for transferring credits to home institutions. Our programs are taught by outstanding local professors from the Universidad de Navarra and by distinguished invited professors from other universities such as Columbia University, Rutgers University, and the University of Miami.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Weekly co-curricular activities to enrich cultural immersion in Spain and to better understand the culture in the context of coursework. Students will have the opportunity to visit many influential sites, learn about the country's unique history, and become immersed in Spanish culture. The following trips and activities in and around Barcelona are led by ILCE professors and are included in the program fee:
