PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Inspired by **Sociocultural Theory** principles from **the field of Applied Linguistics**, this graduate program focuses on how to implement transformative teaching practices and projects in the Second Language (L2) classroom.

Transformative projects are based on classroom activities which promote **meaningful conceptual engagement**.

Participants will enjoy three weeks in Spain, one week in Pamplona, at Universidad de Navarra main campus, and the two following weeks in Barcelona at IESE-Universidad de Navarra campus.

COURSES

This 9 credit program is divided in 3 modules/courses, one for each week:

1. Spanish Linguistic Landscapes
2. Communication & Intercultural Competence in Spanish
3. Spanish Digital Storytelling

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Participants will have the opportunity to enjoy Spanish culture. Cultural events and visits to the many different influential sites in Pamplona and Barcelona such as San Fermín festivities, the Royal Palace of Olite, Sagrada Familia, Parc Güell, and the Gothic Quarter.
