### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

We offer a unique sociocultural online program that helps students improve their Spanish oral and written communicative abilities throughout the semester. Focused on interpersonal communication, linguistic landscape, and digital storytelling, students also develop critical thinking and creative skills through the different course tasks and projects.

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

- **Structure:** students take one or two **accelerated**Spanish Written and Oral Communication Courses **during the Fall semester**, for a total of 6 or 12 ECTS.
- Levels: students will be placed in beginner, intermediate, or advanced level courses. To determine each student's level, the Placement Test should be taken two weeks before the beginning of the session.
- Syllabi are available for transferring credits to home institutions.
- Professors: each course is taught and coordinated by two professors from the Universidad de Navarra or by invited faculty.
- Certification: ILCE offers the possibility of taking an Official Spanish Certification Exam upon completion of the program.
- Dates: Fall semester. Two sessions:
  - Sept. 7th to Oct. 20th
  - Oct. 21st to Dec. 2nd

A minimum of six students must be enrolled in the course the week prior to the start of the session for a level to be offered.

 Schedule: weekly classes Monday-Thursday, between 2-4pm (GMT +2).
